Researching best practices in staging intimacy, nudity, and sexual violence. Specifically focused on the nature of affect theory, de-roling after staging intimacy, and applying foundational theory to practice as research. Founder of two intimacy organizations: Theatrical Intimacy Education and Heartland Intimacy Design & Training. Heartland offers intimacy training entirely online, making intimacy training academic, accessible, and affordable.

Dissertation research exploring works by Sheila Callaghan and Marisa Wegrzyn, two of the co-founders of The Kilroys. Each of the works explored contain a significant amount of violence committed by women, and most of the violence is committed onstage.
