Specifically focused on the nature of affect theory, de-roling after staging intimacy, and applying foundational theory to practice as research. Founder of two intimacy organizations: Theatrical Intimacy Education and Heartland Intimacy Design & Training. Heartland offers intimacy training entirely online, making intimacy training academic, accessible, and affordable.
